**Survey on IBDP Tuition Fee**

The school explained the criteria for setting the IBDP tuition fee and conducted a preliminary consultation at the parent nights on 28-29 November and 1-2 December 2011. According to the guidelines laid out by the EDB, the operation of IBDP programme must be based on a balanced financial scheme, without any cross-subsidization with the local curriculum. Based on the guidelines, IBDP tuition has been calculated to be \$60,000. The data in the table below are listed for your reference:

\* Calculation is based on the assumption that 48 students in each level are taking the IBDP programme yearly.
