[C] Operation

1. The above homework policy is applicable for regular teaching days and for teachers' internal use only.
2. The time suggested is applicable for students of average ability. It is expected that the length of doing homework will be varied according to students' diversity.
3. Chinese, English and Mathematics teachers should give homework every day.
4. Subject teachers should reserve a few minutes for students to finish the homework log before the lesson ends.

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Homework Policy

5. Teachers should design meaningful homework for extending and consolidating students' learning after classes
6. It is recommended that subjects other than Chinese, English and Math should require students to hand in homework on Monday morning or the next day morning, but not during lessons.
7. Self-study Period: Students are allowed to do homework during the last period from Monday to Thursday from 3:30pm to 4:05pm.
